Covid-19 Food Palliative Distribution



FOCUS: Economic Development



LOCATION: The Destitute Home,
Okobaba Village, Ebute Meta, Lagos



PERIOD: December 2020



OBJECTIVE:

To prevent the immediate suffering of some indigent citizens by giving out food supply that can sustain them for a period of time, especially during the COVID-19 crisis.

BENEFICIARIES:

Over 2000 vulnerable people within the remote areas like Makoko, Ikorodu Oko Baba, Ebute Metta and Oworonshoki areas of Lagos State.

PROVISIONS:

5kg each package of food items such as beans, rice, garri, groundnut oil by 1lts, sugar 500g and Salts- 500g were distributed to each individual.

IMPACT:

To Improve lives of some certain communities indigenes by giving them food supply in form of relief for a certain period of time in order to reduce hunger and hardship.

Eradicating hunger and creating an happier environment. The effect of Covid- 19 pandemic on the general masses was a disturbing one which led to increase in poverty and hunger rate across the nation.

December 2020, The Jagal foundation provided Covid-19 Food Palliative items to over 2000 Vulnerable people within the remote areas like Makoko, Ikorodu, The destitues Home Oko Baba, Ebute Metta and Oworonshoki areas of Lagos State by distributing food items such as beans, rice, garri, groundnut oil by 1lts, sugar 500g and Salts- 500g to each individuals in order to releave the immediate suffering which will sustain them for a period of time.
