Donation of Stationery to Government Primary Schools in Lagos State



FOCUS: Education



LOCATION: Government Primary Schools in Lagos State – Alimosho and Agege Local Government Education Authority (LGEA)



PERIOD: April - November 2024





OBJECTIVE:

- To support early education, using appropriate stationery
- To encourage dedication and hard work among the pupils
- To lay a foundation for excellent performance and socio-economic development

BENEFICIARIES:

The outreach benefited 20 government primary schools under Agege and Alimosho Local Government Education Authority (LGEA), covering up to 7,000 pupils and teachers.

Previous distributions include:

2020 – 10,000 pupils across Apapa, Ajah, Makoko, and Ikorodu areas of Lagos

 $2021-1,\!500$ pupils at the Destitute Home, Okobaba Village, Ebute Metta, Lagos

2022 – 16,500 pupils in Ogun and Oyo States

2024 – 7,000 pupils and teachers under Agege and Alimosho LGEA

PROVISION:

 In this phase of the exercise, 35,000 packs, comprising exercise books, pens, and pencils, were distributed.

BENEFICIARIES:

- Promoting environmental education and awareness during the outreach

IMPACT:

- Reinforcement of the government's educational initiatives in 20 public schools in Lagos State
